We will camp in the **Coyote Loop**. **Prior reservations are required and can be made through CA State Parks**. There are water & electricity hook-ups at each site and also a gray water dump. **Do not dump your black tanks at this site**. There is a nearby dump station for our use. **Please remember to bring leveling blocks as they are needed at this campsite.**

### DIRECTIONS:

Coming from the LA (north) area go EAST on HWY 60, exit at the Moreno Beach Dr. off-ramp, at the stoplight, turn right; go 3.2 miles. At the light, turn left onto Via Del Lago. Go up the hill 1.1 miles to the Moreno Gate Kiosk (Park Entrance, this gate is open 24 hours.) Go 1.1 miles to Campground Road then turn right. Lake Perris is well signed all along the way, plus look for our Lazy Daze signs within the park. From the San Diego (south) area, go north on I-215, exit at the Ramona Expressway off-ramp, turn right and go EAST 2.7 miles to Lake Perris Dr. turn left at the lights. Go 1.1 miles to Perris Gate Kiosk (Park Entrance, gate hours 6 am - 8 pm. **No personnel** on duty at this gate. Go 1.4 miles, turn right at the stop sign, go .2 mile; at the next stop sign turn left, go .3 miles; at the third stop sign turn left onto Campground Road. The Coyote Loop is the first road on the right past the Campground Kiosk.

**NOTE: Park Rangers enforce all traffic laws including posted speed limits and tickets will be written.**

**CAMP FEE:** Campers must **pre-register**  
with California State Parks and pay posted park rates.
